TERMS AND CONDITIONS – VIVA RACING LISMORE CUP CALCUTTA GOLF DAY

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the Viva Racing Lismore Cup Calcutta Golf Day (the "Event") held on Thursday 26 September 2024 organised by the Lismore Turf Club.
2. **Eligibility and Entries**
 - 2.1 The Event is open to any amateur golfer over the age of 18 years. Professional golfers are ineligible.
 - 2.2 Participants will enter in teams of four (4).
 - 2.3 A maximum of 36 teams (144 participants) are eligible to participate in the Event. Once 36 teams (144 participants) are registered, the entries will be closed.
 - 2.4 The total entry fee for the Event for each team is \$600. Every team must pay the entry fee in full prior to the commencement of the Event. If a team has not paid its entry fee in full prior to the commencement, then they shall be disqualified.
 - 2.5 *Amateur Golfer means one who plays the game as a non-remunerative and non-profit-making sport and who does not receive remuneration for teaching golf or for other activities because of golf skill or reputation, except as provided in the Rules of Amateur Status.*
3. **Draw and Start Times**
 - 3.1 The Event shall be conducted as a 4-man Ambrose, with a 12pm shotgun start.
 - 3.2 The hole at which each team will commence at shall be determined by the Lismore Turf Club.
4. **Prize Hole - Hole 2**
 - 4.1 If a Hole in One occurs on Hole 2 ("the prize hole"), the participant which scores the hole in one shall win two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) ("the Hole in One prize"). If more than one hole in one occurs on the prize hole, the Hole in One prize shall be split equally between all participants who score a hole in one.
 - 4.2 For example, if two participants both score a hole in one on the prize hole, each successful participant shall receive half of the Hole in One prize each, being the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
 - 4.3 Each participant may only have one attempt on each hole, including the prize hole, and the Event is limited to one round only. Absolutely no practice shots, mulligans, extra or substituted shots are permitted on the prize hole. Only the first shot taken by each contestant is eligible to win in the Hole-in-One prize offered. Mulligan is defined as play providing or purchasing a "do over" or repeat of the previous shot. Mulligans are strictly prohibited.
 - 4.4 A "Hole in One" shall mean a single shot at the prize hole taken by a participant who is competing in the Event, where the ball is struck once and enters the designated hole without contact with any other object or person, and such shot complies with the provisions laid out by Golf Australia. The pin must remain in the designated hole at all times.
 - 4.4 The Event will have an independent scrutineer and the scrutineer's decision shall be final and binding.

5. Course Marker

- 5.1 During the Event a participant shall not place on the course or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements.
- 5.2 A participant in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.

6. Equipment

- 6.1 All equipment (including balls) used during the Event shall conform to the specifications of R & A. The green at the designated hole shall not be specifically prepared or altered from the condition which is usual for normal play, nor shall the hole be positioned on the green to facilitate the achievement of a hole in one.
- 6.2 A participant in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.

7. Code of Conduct

- 7.1 All participants are bound to comply with all of the Lismore Golf Club's rules, policies and regulations. These policies relate to the participant's behaviour and the behaviour of their associates during the tournament. Any breach of these policies may result in the participant being withdrawn from the Event.
- 7.2 It is the duty of the participants and their associates to familiarise themselves with the relevant policies and ensure they comply.

8. Waiver

- 8.1 By entering the Event, each participant releases and holds Lismore Turf Club and each of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, advertisers, promotional agencies, directors, members, successors, sponsors, partners, licensees, officers, agents, employees, artists, advisors, and assignees, and each individual or entity associated with the Event harmless from and against any and all losses, damages, rights, claims, and actions of any kind arising in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from the participation in the Event, or resulting directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize awarded in connection with the Event, including (to the extent permitted by law) without limitation claims based on negligence, breach of contract or liability for physical injury, death, or property damage.

9. Events beyond control

- 9.1 If for any reason any aspect of this Event is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure, weather event or any cause beyond the control of the Lismore Turf Club, Lismore Turf Club may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Event and invalidate any affected entries, or suspend or modify a prize, subject to the laws and regulations of New South Wales.

These terms and conditions and this Event are governed by the laws of New South Wales
